Students starting in Byblos

Students who start in Byblos may complete the first 3-4 semesters in Byblos. For the last 3-4 semesters, they need to transfer to the Beirut camps and complete their program there. Or they can split their courses between Beirut (T-TH) and Byblos (MWF). The department will try its best to schedule all required second/third year courses in Beirut on Tuesday-Thursday to limit the number of visits Byblos students need to make.

Students starting Fall 2018

Students who started their study in Fall 2018 should we be aware of some minor changes in the LAC program. The following courses no longer count toward LAC: ETH 201, HLT 201, PED elective. Instead of these courses, students who start in Fall 2018 get an extra free elective. This is marked in the study plan in the last semester: "LAC (or Free Elective if you started in Fall 2018)."
