INFORMATION SHEET

CAMP DESCRIPTION:

The three-week summer camp aims to introduce a new way of **Music, Dance and Acting** education to the young generation; that combines fun and rigorous traditions to grow their love and appreciation to the arts. The faculty are carefully selected from part and full time LAU faculty. Emphasis is placed on the creative process, hands-on learning and collaborative projects as campers work toward performances for their families to enjoy at the end of camp. The camp will offer **five different scholarships** for students interested in pursuing their undergraduate studies in the Department of Communication Arts at LAU; 30%, 20%, 15% and three 10% scholarships.

MISSION:

At Imagine, we aim to build a **non-competitive** community amongst the students; while ensuring that they are getting the most of their experience. We will help them gain **self-confidence, self-awareness and independence**. Through the impeccable talents and experience of our faculty; your child will discover, experience, develop and expand their imagination and expression skills.

TIME AND PLACE:

The camp takes place at the Lebanese American University – Beirut Campus. All activities from rehearsals to the final performance will take place at LAU. The dates are Monday July 16th to Friday August 3rd, Imagine Camp takes place on weekdays only. All students must be available all camp days between 8:30am and 3:45pm, except:

- Wednesday and Thursday of the third week, students stay until 7pm
- Friday day (performance day) students stay until 9pm.

CAMP FEE:

\$795 (Inc. VAT) per student, children of LAU faculty, staff and alumni get a special rate of \$500

SCHEDULE:

A regular day will follow this schedule (Subject to slight changes):

- Drop off and check-in: 8:00am
- First class: 8:30 – 9:40am
- Second class: 9:50 – 11:00am
- Lunch: 11:00 – 12:00pm
- All student workshop: 12:00 – 1:00pm
- Third class: 1:10 – 2:20pm
- Fourth class: 2:30 – 3:40pm
- Check-out and pick-up: 3:45pm

CLASSES:

Imagine Summer Arts Camp focuses on three art disciplines:

- Music: Classical Chamber Music, Piano, Voice and Choir, and Rock Band. Students are expected to bring their own musical instruments except for drum set, keyboard and piano.
- Dance: different styles and dance techniques. Students are expected to bring their own dance shoes.
- Acting: Acting and set designing.

REGISTRATION:

- Read this document carefully.
- Fill out the camp application found on <http://comm.lau.edu.lb/Imagine> - and attached the needed document and camp fee to your application.
- Turn all the above in person to Ms. Annie Tabakian at the Department of Communication Arts – Nicol Hall GOO2 – LAU Beirut. Alternatively, email the signed and scanned application along with the needed documents to annie.tabakian@lau.edu.lb
- Deadline is July 1st, in case of cancelation before June 1st, the camp tuition will be refunded. No refunds after that date is granted.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- Drop-off is no earlier than 8:00am and no later than 8:25am. Must be at Middle Gate.
- Pick up is no earlier than 3:45pm and no later than 4:10pm. Must be at Middle Gate.
- There's one public performance on the final day of camp at 7:30pm in Irwin Theatre.
- On the last day of camp all students must be picked up after the performance.

WHAT TO BRING:

- A plastic or metal water bottle that can be refilled throughout the day. No glass—please.
- A wholesome lunch and snacks. Nothing that needs refrigeration or re-heating.
- Your musical instrument and its accessories, except for drum-set and piano/keyboard.
- Notebook and pencils.

- Shoes should be fully enclosed. No flip-flops, sandals or crocs.
- Costumes and concert clothes will be decided during camp.
